Trails Committee Minutes  
May 12, 2025

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:06 pm.
2. Minutes from last meeting – The minutes from the February 10, 2025 meeting were read and approved with a correction. Also it was observed that X-C skis are still at the school.
3. Black Hills
  - a. Map: almost done. Double-checking GPS coordinates at junctions. We can then print maps for the kiosks.
  - b. All trails need maintenance.
  - c. We can also make signs for invasives and other info. Make people aware of what to do if they spot any invasive plants: take a photo with location turned on and send.
  - d. Info documents needed:
    - i. how to report invasive plants
    - ii. how to use your phone on the trails, including various map/tracking apps, using airplane mode to conserve battery life, using SOS feature.
    - iii. Michelle will create these.
4. Lake Parker loop
  - a. Saunders family is willing to sell the land at the south end, although their asking price is an issue. We will look into whether we could get grant money before making a proposal to the select board. We will also look into how much it would cost to put a small (3 car) parking area across the street from the lake.
  - b. We will walk the path from Parker Rd to the Parker Settlement and track it along the way so that we can map the whole Hinman Hiking Trail on the east side of the lake. Meet on Thursday May 14 at 10:00 at the West Glover Church.
  - c. Signs -- what do we need? Nature and other info, Peggy's timeline, directions such as the route to take around the edges of the fields
5. Lyman trails near the school
  - a. Bob S. would like to check them out but doesn't know where to find them. Ann will find out and let him know.
  - b. Bucky Shelton uses these trails; the VAST trail also goes through there.
6. Walking path from town green
  - a. a path along the river would be nice. 25' on either side of river is right of way.
  - b. The state owns the first stretch from Still Hill Rd. There's a small path already there on the road side of the river.
  - c. Heather Clark / David Bock had a trail along the river that got flooded. They are open to the idea of a path.
  - d. Let's take a walk and explore: Monday June 2 at 10:00, starting from town green.
7. Pickleball court update
  - a. Slab was poured

- b. Ordered posts and net but the slab doesn't have holes for the posts. Should we make holes, or get different posts? Possibilities were discussed, will first try to get different posts.
  - c. Surface will be a sports surface on the concrete.
- 8. Lumber order
  - a. Dominic will order cedar from David Young
  - b. Benches are the first priority, then fence posts.
  - c. where should it be delivered? Peggy will confirm delivering to her house.
